- Completes utility tasks that are designated the responsibility of EH&S including:
- Facility safety implementation through safe work practices.
- Manages the organization, structure and accessibility of the waste storage area.
- Helps keep the grounds outside the structures clean, organized, inventoried and free from debris and scrap.
- Helps to ensure that site waste streams are monitored, managed and disposed.
- Executes tasks assigned by the Corporate EH&S Manager and the Senior Staff IH including:
- equipment cleanout
- Pumps waste to the sewer under our discharge permits
- Works with our facilities manager to help with projects required by EH&S
- Helps our logistics lead in the warehouse as needed and approved.
- Is proficient at forklift operations and can be trained and designated as an OSHA Forklift Train the Trainer.
- Is able to do daily inspections of forklift operations and document them.
- Is proficient at articulating man lift operations and can be trained and designated as an OSHA Forklift Train the Trainer.
